11. ENVIRONMENTAL ENFORCEMENT (DCES)

1 Summary

1.1 To increase the Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN) level for graffiti and fly posting.

2 Details

- 2.1 A report was tabled at the November 2018 Policy and Resources Committee and at Council in December 2018 to introduce a new Fixed Penalty Notice (FPN) and to increase the level of a number of existing FPNs; littering, graffiti and fly posting.
- 2.2 The level for the littering FPN was approved (Minute CL57/18 refers), however the recommendation omitted that this should also apply for graffiti and fly posting.
- 2.3 This report therefore seeks Council approval to increase the FPN level for graffiti and fly posting to £150 (previously £75) reduced to £100 if paid with seven days.
- 3 Options and Reasons for Recommendations
- 3.1 Now there is the option to increase the level of FPN, officers feel that by doing so this will act as a further deterrent against committing these offences.
