LC03/18 GAMBLING ACT 2005 – REVIEW OF STATEMENT OF LICENSING POLICY

The report seeks Members' consideration of the draft Statement of Gambling Principles and Policy for the period 2018–2021 (hereafter referred to as "the draft Statement of Policy"). The draft Statement of Policy must be published no later than 3 January 2019 to come in to force by 31 January 2019. This would replace the current Statement of Policy (2016 – 2019) which was agreed in December 2015.

The Lead Licensing Officer advised that the Statement of Licensing Policy had to be reviewed every three years and this was now due to take place. Some small changes had been made to the Policy including:

- The no casinos resolution had now been added at Appendix 4.
- The inclusion to the types of premises that could apply for gambling licenses.
- Graphs had been simplified and were easier to read.

A Member was pleased to see the inclusion of the proximity of schools and residential areas to be taken into consideration when determining applications to grant a gambling premises license.
