## STREET NAMING AND NUMBERING CHARGES FROM 1 APRIL 2020

The allocation of a new name or number is free of charge. Once the number/name has been allocated, there is a charge to notify statutory undertakers and other interested parties, such as Royal Mail and emergency services. Notification will also include other statutory undertakers and internal departments of the Council such as Council Tax/Non Domestic Rates, Elections and Waste Management.

When multiple Plots are mentioned, please note that the fee is a total price for the number of plots and not the fee for individual plots within that range.
