

What are we doing?

High Speed two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. As part of our preparation to build the railway we will be carrying out works on Chalfont Lane, Maple Cross. As part of these works, HS2 Ltd will be closing Chalfont Lane for approximately 8 years from 8 November 2017 until early 2026. Additionally, over the next few months you will also see the installation of slip roads to and from the M25, the widening of Chalfont Lane for construction traffic, the diversion of two water mains, and a new public link road between Shire Lane and Hornhill Road for diverted local traffic.

Why is this being done?

To ensure as little disruption as possible on local roads, we are building slip roads to and from the M25 and widening Chalfont Lane for heavy goods vehicles. The slip roads will be used by heavy goods vehicles to directly access the construction sites adjacent to Chalfont Lane and the A412. As part of this work we will also be diverting two water mains in proximity to Chalfont Lane, to prepare for the site for construction. To reduce the impact on local residents, we are also building a new link road between Hornhill Road and Shire Lane for diverted traffic which will open early in 2018.

How will this affect me and who can I speak to?

Chalfont Lane will close from Wednesday 8 November for approximately eight years. However, access will remain open for Sunny Hill Road residents and for The Orchards site. Whilst Chalfont Lane is closed there will be a temporary diversion in place until the new link road is opened. You will notice the works underway with site compounds and workers in the land to the south of Chalfont Lane and adjacent to the M25.

Working hours

- Our contractors will start works on Monday 23
 October, Chalfont Lane will be closed from the 8
 November.
- Normal working hours: Monday to Friday 8am-6pm, with the potential for some works taking place on Saturdays between 8am-1pm.
- Our contractors may also be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown.

What to expect

- The sites will be secured with construction fencing.
- The closure of Chalfont Lane from 8 November 2017 for approximately 8 years.

What we will do


- Inform you in advance of any changes to the dates shown.
- Keep all sites safe and secure.
- Ensure that the contractor vehicles over 7.5 tonnes use agreed routes.
- Provide updates on the status of works.



Parts of Shire Lane bridleway (CPS/44/1 & Ricks002) which runs along the county boundary are also due to close. However, we will aim to keep it open as long as possible prior to closing it and initially any closure may be limited to crossing the M25 only. The bridleway which runs alongside the present quarry access (Ricks004) will also be crossed by a temporary haul road to divert the water mains in the short term.

All works will be carried out within our working hours of Monday-Friday 8am-6pm, and Saturdays 8am-1pm with setting up and closing down activity for no more than 1 hour either side of these times.

Our contractor will also keep you updated on the detail of the works as they progress.
