
Materials:

Windows - Timber window machined up less the thickness of the aluminium profile and joined using traditional scribe and tenon joints. he aluminum profile is then cut and bonded to size. Once cured and powder coated it is fitted to the glazed, timber part using nylon clips and sealed with a rubber gasket. The overall thickness of the window is now the same as a standard all timber version.



Plinth Brick - Old Coachhouse Code 70 Bricks by Traditional Brick & Stone Ltd (see picture)







Proposed Tiles




Proposed Bricks (English Bond, not as shown)





