

Three Rivers Community Safety Priorities 2024-/2025

The Three Rivers Community Safety Priorities 2024-2025 identify the focus of work being tackled by the Community Safety Partnership (CSP) outside of what is regarded daily business. The priorities have been shaped by the CSP Strategic Assessment incorporating the risk assessment. The priorities are not exclusively based on those findings, they incorporate local thoughts and concerns.

All Priorities listed are areas that need focus and attention in 2024-25.

The priorities are:

- 1. Burglary
- 2. Theft of and Theft from Motor Vehicle
- 3. Robbery (shop lifting)
- 4. Anti-social Behaviour and Youth Crime
- 5. Domestic Abuse
- 6. Violence Against Women and Girls
- 7. Hate Crime and Prevent

The engagement, commitment, and support of the Community Safety Partnership, which is made up of statutory partner agencies, Police, Fire and Rescue, Probation, and Health along with non-statutory agencies, working in collaboration, will manage a wealth of support, awareness, and challenges relating to the priorities set for 2024-2025. The Anti-Social Behaviour Action Group (ASBAG), Domestic Abuse & Violence against Women and Girls Forum (DA & VAWG) and Southwest Herts Youth Action Panel (SWHYAP) will be critical to the success of this work and enhancing our understanding of Three Rivers District.
